

Inspections requests are fulfilled next day, guaranteed within 2 days




You can check the status of any permit on Pasco Gateway



No permit should take more than 18 days for approval or for revision requested






All work in a flood zone requires a permit*

There are no special procedures for damaged structures outside a flood zone, but you generally need a permit.

Building Forward: 2025 Season

- New changes in the law
- Cumulative damage calculations are gone!
- Fees will be waived for 90 days
- Storm permits will be expedited
- Contracts can no longer legally be required, but greatly speed up permitting.





Hurricane Repairs Scope of Work Questionnaire

Pasco County Building Construction Services has created this Substantial Implementary Damage Tool for citizens who were affected by Hurricanes Helene and Milto expediting the review process for Residential Alteration Permits.

For restoration repairs related to Hurricanes Helene and Milton, or if the property is zone, a Residential Alteration permit is necessary. Based on the extent of da homeowner reports through this form, and the supporting documentation the home contractor provides, this tool automatically calculates labor and material costs County citizens.

This tool also replaces the Scope of Work Narrative/Questionnaire (required per Building Code 107.2.1), information on construction documents, and the downlo Substantial Improvement and Damage Package.

Please note: This is a guide. If at any point the applicant determines the scope of construction responsibility to be further than their understanding, it is imperative they hire a lice contractor. The Building Department cannot assist in filling out the Substantial Improvement Damage Tool.
